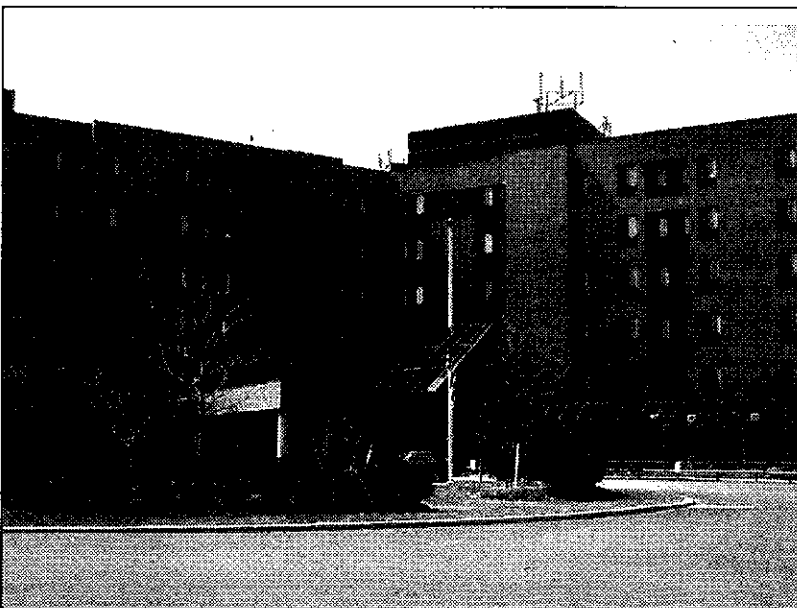


Jewish Home 90th Anniversary Gala



The Jewish Home Foundation will be hosting a gala celebration Sunday, October 17 to mark The Jewish Home of Greater Rochester's 90th anniversary. Highlights of the event include a cocktail party and kosher dinner catered by New York City's Main Event, and a world premier performance featuring Mandy Patinkin and Nathan Gunn.

Patinkin is a star of Broadway, film and television. His awards include a Tony Award® for his role in Andrew Lloyd Webber's "Evita," a Golden Globe nomination for his role of Avigdor in "Yentl," and an Emmy® Award for his performance in the CBS series "Chicago Hope." His feature film credits include "The Princess Bride," "Ragtime" and "Dick Tracy." He has also starred in the television series "Dead Like Me" and "Criminal Minds."

Nathan Gunn is one of the most in-demand baritones of the day. He has appeared in renowned opera houses such as the Metropolitan Opera, San Francisco Opera and Paris Opera, and wit well-known orchestras including the New York Philharmonic and Boston Symphony. Patinkin and Gunn have not previously performed together.
